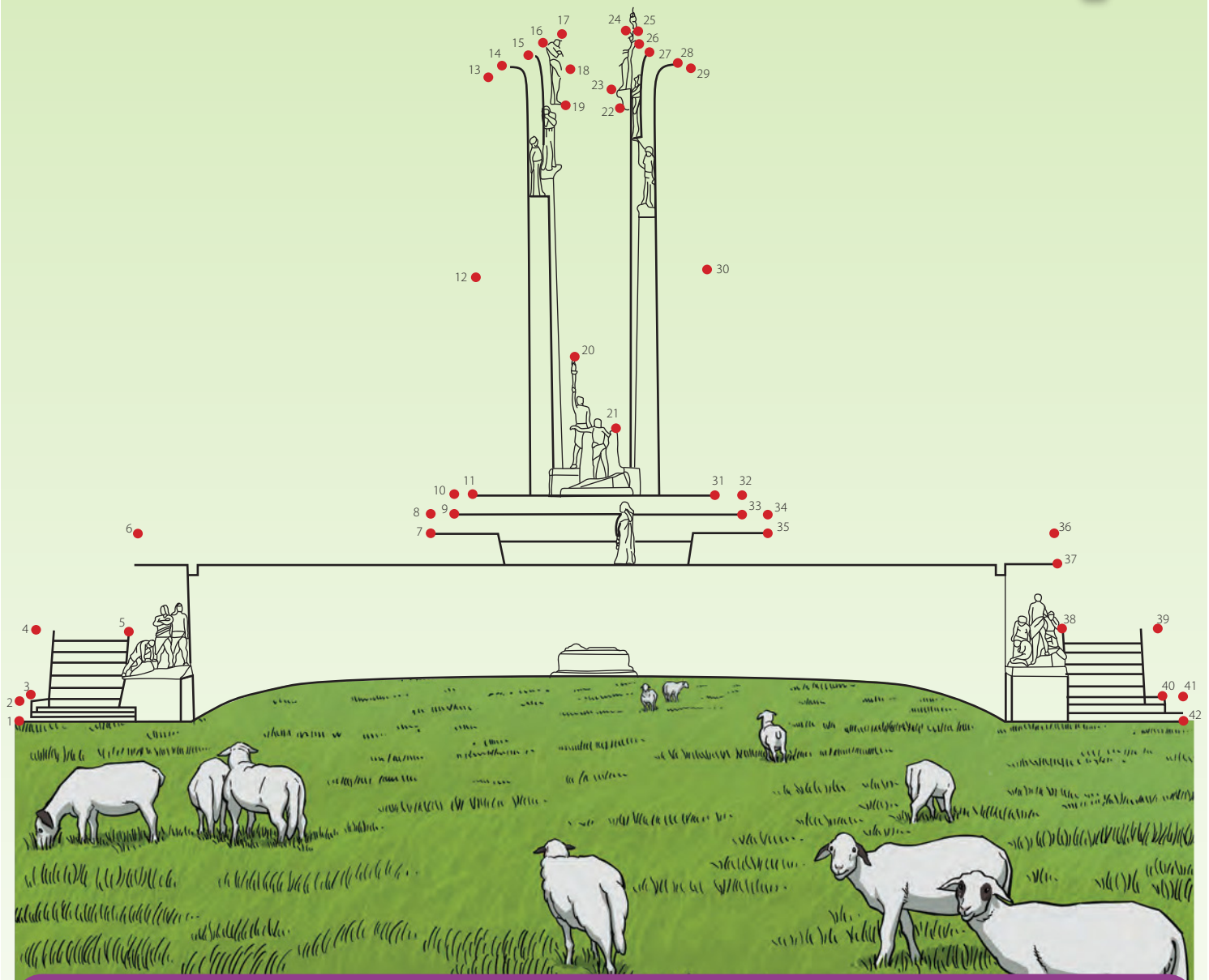

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National Aboriginal Veterans Monument

Many Indigenous people have served in Canada's military. The National Aboriginal Veterans Monument helps us honour them.

Four warriors (two men and two women) represent First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples. Around them are sculptures of symbolic animals. There is an eagle, grizzly bear, caribou, wolf and bison.

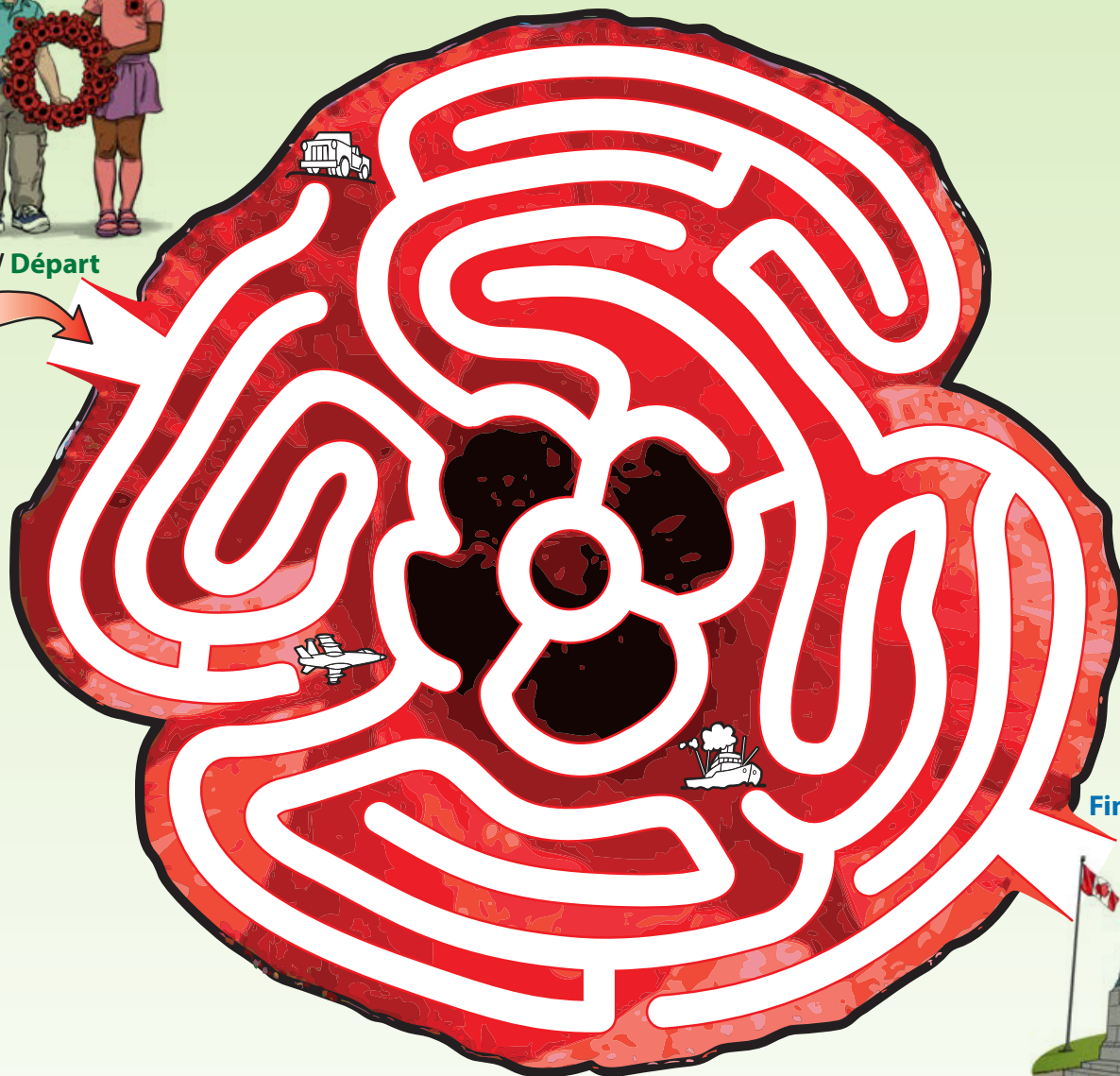

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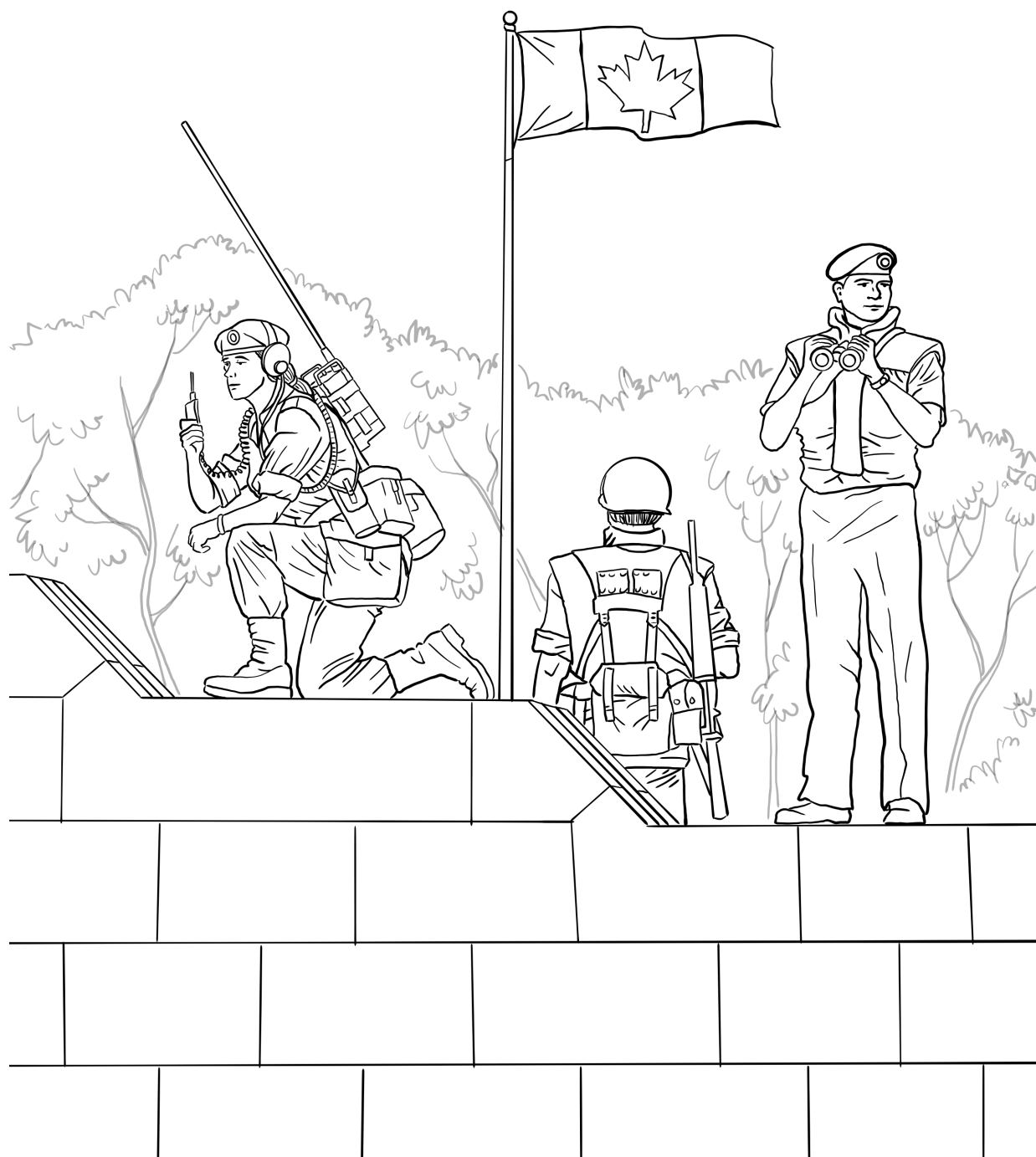
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Reconciliation: The Peacekeeping Monument

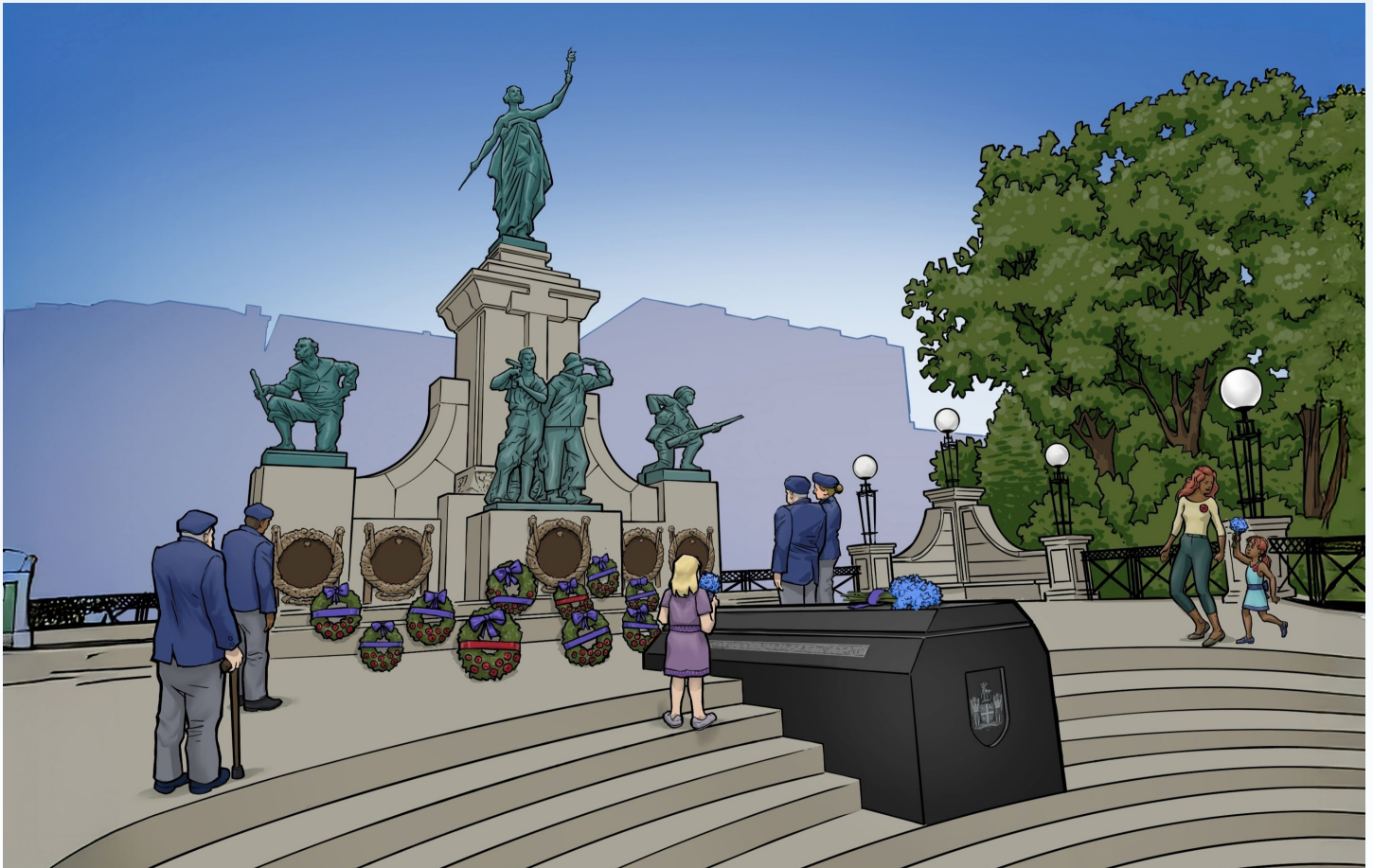

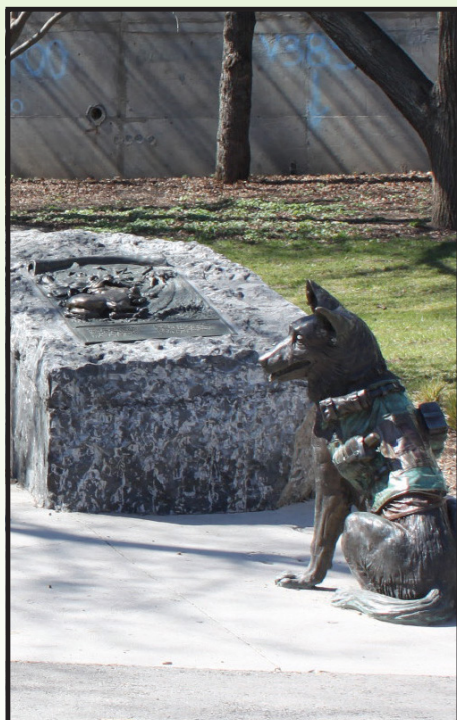
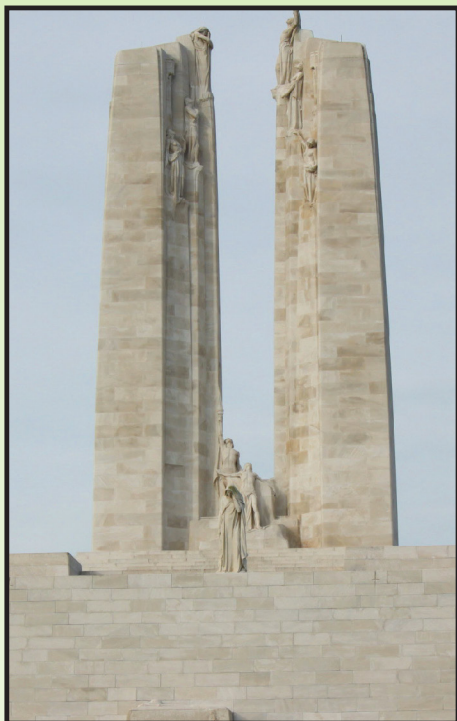
Pax is part of a flock of sheep that works there. They help by eating the grass to keep it short!

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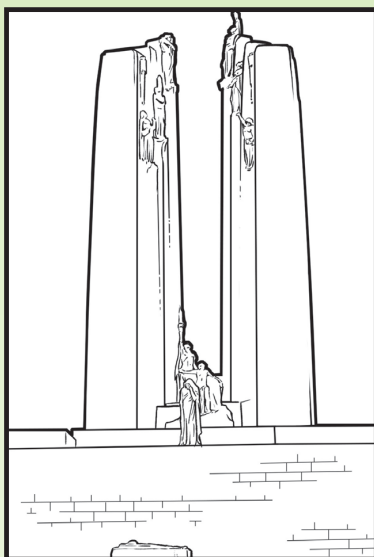

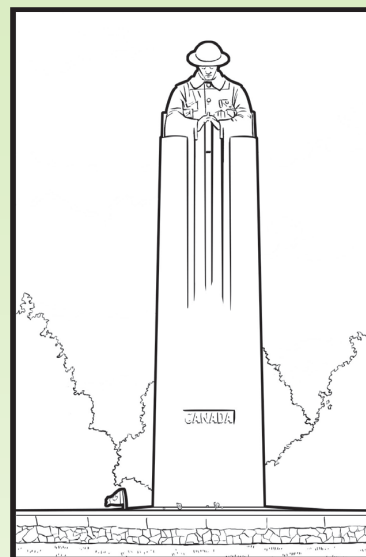

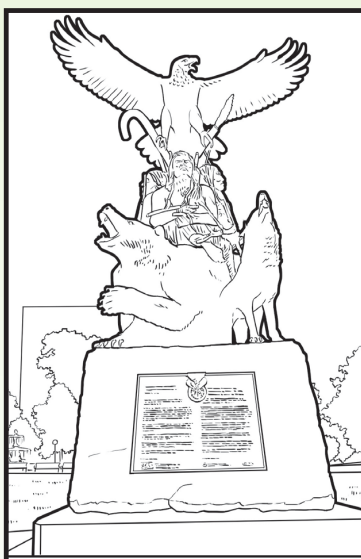

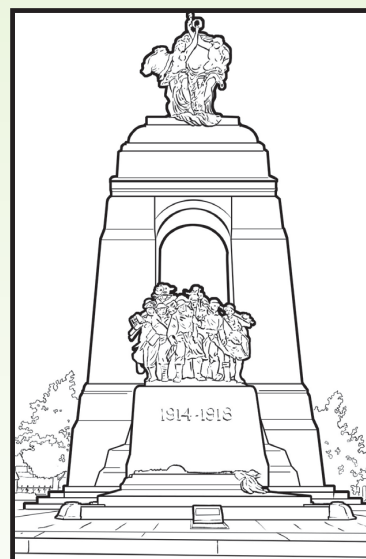

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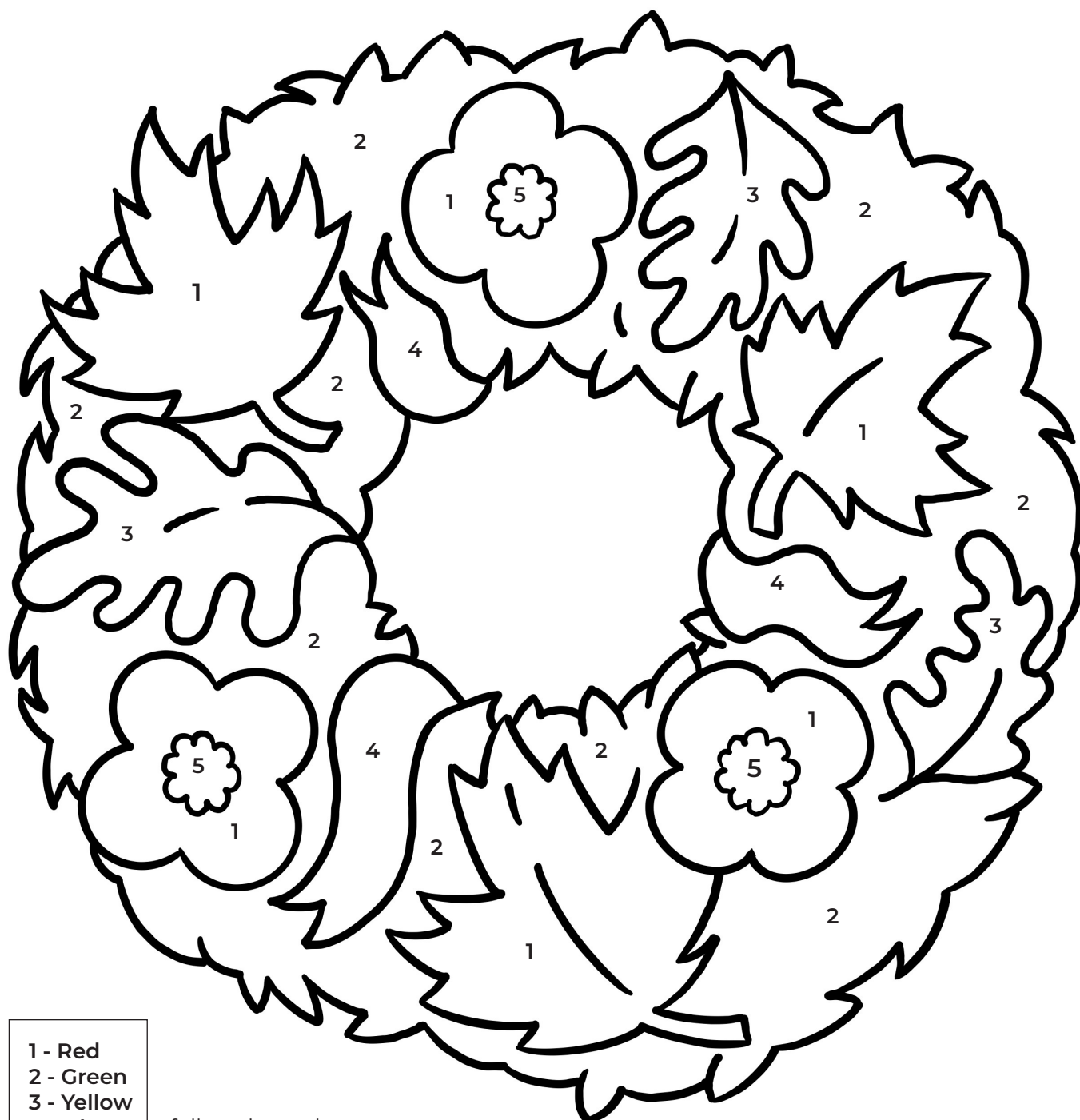
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Wreath
